### THE CLUB

## **SAILING**

Whilst most sailing take place on Wednesday evenings from 6:00pm and Saturdays and Sundays from 11:00am to 5:00pm, Water use is also allowed from dawn until dusk, 7 days a week.

The main sailing season usually runs from April to October each year when the safety boat is generally manned by a rota of members at selected times.

Kayaking, Canoeing and SUP use is also permitted by full members of the club.
